

CHAPTER NINE

THE 77 SIGNATURE

DANIEL: Both genealogies of Jesus have long been a mystery and a subject of controversy to those theologians who think that God is a mono-sexed entity. The reality is anyone and everyone who is born into this world has two genealogies—one from the father and one from the mother. The supernatural genealogy for the Son of God in Luke¹ clearly ascends to God the Father, while the Mother's genealogy in Matthew² naturally descends from Abraham to Jesus. Both genealogies deliver Jesus' 77 signature.

THOMAS: I remember 77, 77, 77 before, but you didn't explain it.

DANIEL: Following a list of 40 Patriarchs, this verse divides 42 generations in the genealogy of the Son of Man, who is Jesus.

So all the generations from Abraham unto David are <u>fourteen</u> generations; and from David unto the carrying away to Babylon <u>fourteen</u> generations; and from the carrying away to Babylon unto the Christ fourteen generations.²

THOMAS: It doesn't say 77, 77, and 77.

DANIEL: Consider that 14 is 7+7 so that the generations 14, 14, and 14 are also 7+7, 7+7, and 7+7, that is expressed as 77, 77, and 77.

THOMAS: This is phony numerology.

DANIEL: I call this "Divine Equivocation", where God equates numbers to a man, like 666 to the beast, or 77 to the Son of Man, or 777 to
